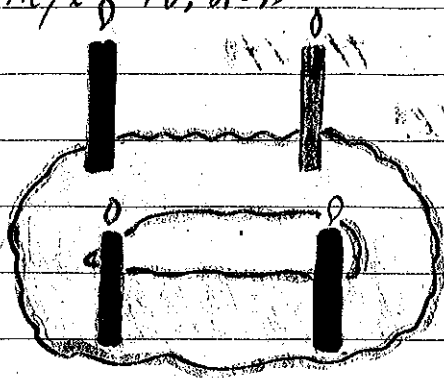

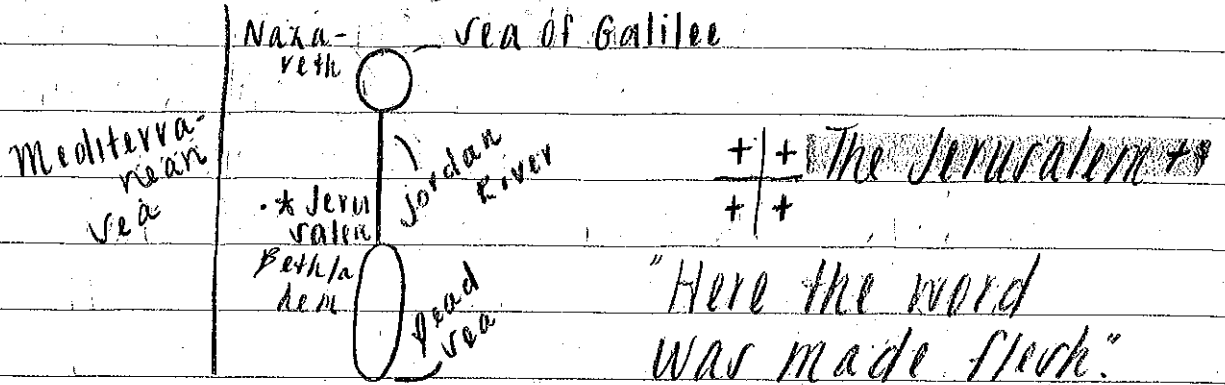

A) Bible - Luke 1, "Kecharitome"

↳ translated 'full of grace'

↳ it is a title given only to Mary.

↳ it appears nowhere else in

ancient Greek writing.

↳ it means highly favored by God,
blessed w/ supernatural continuing
grace!

B) In 1854, Pope Pius 9 proclaims the
I.C. as dogma: unchanging Church
