sacrifices

Abraham follows God's command completely, even though he does not understand it.

This was because he trusted God with everything.

At Mt. Moriah, Abraham puts the wood on Isaac's shoulders on the hill where the son would be killed.

Abraham binds Isaac, but Isaac could easily have escaped. Isaac was a willing sacrifice.

An angel stops A. from completing the sacrifice. Father and son both had been tested, and they both passed: they both put God first.

A. finds a ram caught in a thicket, and sacrifices it instead.

2000 yrs. later the father  
(God) would sacrifice His only son  
( $\lambda$ ) on a hill ~~to~~ to save us from
