13. Redemption/Salvation: Christ paid the price for our salvation (Heaven) by dying for us.

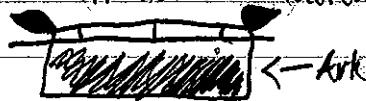
14. God made a covenant with the Israelites (Chosen People) as a sign of His faithfulness.

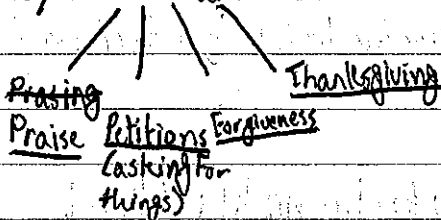

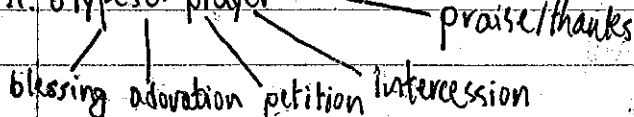
