peace: not merely the absence of conflict; it is the fullness of right relationship.

The peace between God and humanity has already been bought and paid for: by λ 's blood. We just need to accept His gift by the life we live.

3 Theological Virtues (1 Corinthians 13)

Faith: a gift of God and a human act by which the believer gives full assent to God and on God has revealed

Hope: theological virtue by which the person both desires and expects heaven, and the grace to attain it.

Love: a decision more than an emotion to will the highest good for someone else.

→ cannot be earned; only accepted as a gift. They are infused in the soul at baptism.

pardon = forgiveness

To forgive means NOT saying the sin was okay; it IS giving the person a chance to change (repent)

sow = to plant, like seeds

"Where there is darkness, light" → spiritual work of mercy; instruct the ignorant (this is our job!)

joy: a deep contentment because you know because God loves you; it is bigger than your circumstances
